

1. Lilo's Hawaiian Lei Relay

Objective: Be the first team to complete the relay by passing the lei without dropping it. **Setup:** Prepare several Hawaiian leis. Divide the children into two or more teams, and have them line up in rows.

How to Play: The first child in each line places a lei around their neck. They must pass the lei to the next person without using their hands, using only their neck and head. If the lei drops, they must start again. The first team to successfully pass the lei down the line and back wins.

2. Stitch's Space Tag

Objective: Avoid being tagged by the "Alien Catcher" while collecting space gems. **Setup:** Scatter shiny or glowing "space gems" (small balls or glow sticks) around the play area. Designate one child as the "Alien Catcher" (the tagger) and others as "Space Explorers."

How to Play: The Alien Catcher tries to tag the Space Explorers, who are collecting as many space gems as possible. Once tagged, a player must freeze in place with their gem until another explorer tags them to unfreeze. The game ends when all gems are collected or a set time limit is reached. The player with the most gems wins.



3. Lilo's Luau Limbo

Objective: See who can go the lowest under the limbo stick.

Setup: Use a limbo stick or a decorated pool noodle held by two adults. Play Hawaiian-themed music.

How to Play: Children take turns bending backward to pass under the limbo stick without touching it or falling. After each round, lower the stick. The last child standing without touching the stick wins.

4. Stitch's Coconut Bowling

Objective: Knock down all the pins using a "coconut."

Setup: Set up bowling pins (or decorated water bottles) in a triangle formation. Use a brown ball as the "coconut."

How to Play: Each child gets two rolls to knock down as many pins as possible. Keep score, and the child with the highest number of pins knocked down after everyone has had a turn wins.

5. Lilo's Surfboard Balance Challenge

Objective: Balance on the "surfboard" (balance board) for as long as possible. **Setup:** Make or purchase an exercise balance board.

How to Play: Children take turns standing on the "surfboard" and balancing. The longer they stay on without falling, the better. To make it more challenging, introduce tasks like clapping or keeping hands up in the air, while balancing on the board. The child who balances the longest wins.

6. Stitch's Galactic Jump

Objective: Jump the farthest or highest while pretending to be in zero gravity. **Setup:** Mark a starting line and provide a soft landing area, like a mat or grass. You can also set up a vertical target (like a hanging streamer) for a height challenge. **How to Play:** Children take turns running and jumping as far as they can from the starting line, or jumping to reach the height target. Measure the distance or height of each jump. The child with the farthest or highest jump wins. To make it more fun, encourage the kids to jump in creative "alien" styles, just like Stitch might!



7. Lilo's Pineapple Toss

Objective: Score the most points by successfully tossing pineapples into baskets. **Setup:** Set up several baskets or containers at different distances, each labeled with a different point value (e.g., 10, 20, 30 points). Use small foam pineapples or balls decorated like pineapples.

How to Play: Children take turns tossing the pineapples into the baskets. Each player gets three tosses per turn. Keep track of their points after each round. The player with the most points at the end of the game wins a small prize.

8. Stitch's Space Scavenger Hunt

Objective: Collect all the hidden space-themed objects around the party area. **Setup:** Hide small space-related items (like mini UFOs, planets, or star stickers) around the party area. Provide each child with a list or images of the items they need to find. **How to Play:** Divide the kids into teams or let them play individually. They must search the area for the hidden items and check them off their list when found. The first to find all the items wins a small prize.

9. Stitch's Alien Drawing Contest

Objective: Create the most creative alien design.

Setup: Provide each child with Lilo and Stitch coloring pages and markers or crayons. You can also have some craft supplies like googly eyes, glitter, and stickers for added creativity.

How to Play: Kids will decorate their own Stitch or one of his "cousins." Once done, have an adult or older child judge the aliens based on creativity, uniqueness, and effort. Winners can receive small prizes, and everyone gets to take their alien drawing home.

10. Lilo and Stitch Trivia Challenge

Objective: Answer the most questions correctly to win the title of "Lilo and Stitch Expert." **Setup:** Prepare a set of Lilo and Stitch-related trivia questions. These can be about the movie's plot, characters, quotes, and fun facts. Write each question on an index card or prepare a digital version on a device. Arrange the kids in a circle or around a table. If you want, prepare small prizes for the winners.



How to Play:

Round Setup: Start with the children sitting in a circle or around a table. Choose a trivia host (an adult or an older child) who will ask the questions. Divide the players into two teams or let them play individually.

Question Rounds: The host reads a question aloud, and the first player or team to raise their hand or buzz in (using a simple noise-making device or just clapping) gets to answer the question. If they answer correctly, they earn a point. If the answer is incorrect, another player or team can try to answer.

Multiple Choice Option: For younger children, you can make the questions multiplechoice to make it easier and more fun.

Bonus Rounds: Include a few bonus rounds with more challenging questions or ask the players to act out a scene or quote from the movie. Award extra points for creativity or accuracy.

Winning: After all the questions have been asked, tally up the points. The player or team with the most points wins the game and earns the title of "Lilo and Stitch Expert."

Consider giving small prizes like Lilo and Stitch-themed stickers or toys.
